REPORT

1.0 BACKGROUND

Appearing on the Council Agenda is a letter dated 1988 November 30 from the Superintendent of Schools advising that the Board of School Trustees has two requests in relation to the approval process associated with the redevelopment guidelines for the Edmonds School site.

The first has to do with the participation of the School District in the presentation of information at the Open House that was held on 1988 December 08. At the time of writing, Municipal and School District staff are collaborating on the preparation of materials to be available at the Open House that will include information provided by the School District. Two members of the School District staff have agreed to be in attendance at the Open House to help answer questions.

The second item has to do with the Board's acceptance of the offer from Council to have a joint meeting between the Board, the Parks and Recreation Commission and Council concerning the redevelopment guidelines. Following the holding of the Open House and a review of the comment sheets related to the proposed guidelines, staff will be preparing a recommendation for the consideration of Council. Once this material has been submitted to Council and forwarded to the School Board and the Parks and Recreation Commission, it would be appropriate to hold the joint meeting, prior to the final consideration of the recommended land use guidelines.
