REPORT


At its meeting dated 1988 December 01, the Burnaby Public Library Board reviewed cost estimates and plans for the proposed Metrotown library. The revised Civic Facilities Joint Project Budget was considered by the Library Board. Particular attention was paid to the designs and plans for the library which are now in their final stages. It was formally moved, seconded and carried

"That the Library Board give its formal approval to the library project estimates and plans, and inform Municipal Council, urging that Council support the project, call for tenders and proceed with construction as soon as possible."

The Library Board also considered the Metrotown library within the context of the joint project and it was moved, seconded and carried

"That the Library Board convey to Municipal Council its support for the concept of the joint project, including the library, public parking and the civic square."
