REPORT OF THE HOUSING COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT staff prepare an inventory of public and private lands suitable to accommodate low density, ground oriented housing to either be sold or leased for that purpose.

R E P O R T

The Housing Committee, at its meeting held on 1988 February 10, discussed the allocation of areas suitable for low density, ground-oriented housing, subsidized housing programs that are in effect and leasing of municipally owned housing sites.

The Committee agreed that priority should be given to the process of locating and identifying sites within the municipality with potential for low density ground-oriented housing. Staff have generated this type of information on past occasions for various organizations on request but this information requires updating to reflect the current status.

The question of selling or leasing municipal lands for low density, ground-oriented housing has and will continue to be addressed on an individual merit basis in connection with specific development proposals.
