ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The 1988 Capital


Budget contains provision for an

 flow in the Loughheed Mall apartment area.
 Construction is scheduled for completion
 prior to pavement rehabilitation through
 the Local Improvement Program. Funds are
 available in the 1988 Capital Budget under
 code 60-21, Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.
