RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for the information of Council.

R E P O R T

During the inquiry period at the Council meeting of 1988 06 13, Council requested an investigation and report on the feasibility of developing the 7th Street road allowance between Berkley Street and the Lakeview School property (see attached sketch).

In response to this request we have prepared two estimates, one for a full curb standard with a cul-de-sac and the other to construct only an interim asphalt pavement with a vehicle turn-around.

The full standard with curbs is \$28,050.00.

The interim standard with turn-around is \$24,750.00.

Engineering Department staff is of the opinion that, if the road were to be built, it should be done to the finished standard. However, it is also felt that this project would be of relatively low priority in terms of benefit to the general public and, in any event, there is no specific provision for it in the 1988 Capital Budget. The earliest opportunity for Council to make budget provision for this project would be during preparation of the 1989 Capital Budget.

This report is for the information of Council.
