1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.


REPORT

At its meeting of 1988 January 11 Council requested the Parks & Recreation Commission to conduct a poll at both Bonsor Recreation Complex and Cameron Recreation Centre with a view of obtaining the opinion of users relative to the sale of alcohol in the complex restaurants.

Council requested that the poll be conducted 6 months after the opening of the Bonsor Complex (both complexes to be done at the same time) and that users be asked whether or not they would support the sale of alcoholic beverages in a limited manner in the complex restaurants.

It was also requested by Council that a copy of the questionnaire be provided to it for information prior to the conducting of the poll.

Because of the delays in the opening of Bonsor Recreation Complex, the Commission proposes to conduct the survey in 1989 March. The questionnaire will be provided to Council in 1989 January.
