For the information of Council, at the 1987 November 16 Council meeting the recommendation of the Urban Design Study related to the siting of Phase I facilities was adopted and referred to the Library Board and the Parks and Recreation Commission for endorsement. The Burnaby Library Board at its meeting of 1987 November 19 confirmed its approval of the Willingdon Avenue Metrotown Resource Library location identified in the Urban Design Study, and the Parks and Recreation Commission at its meeting of 1987 December 16 had no objections to the siting of the Phase I facilities (Resource Library, Civic Square, Public Parking).
