REPORT

60-60-022 Office renovations in the Building Inspection Division.
CHARGE: 1988 Capital Budget
Code 60: Municipal Hall \$15,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The 1988 Operating Budget contained provision for renovations to accommodate existing and additional staff in the Building Inspection Division of the Planning and Building Inspection Department. The renovations were delayed and funding was capitalized pending a review of the proposed asbestos removal and study of space requirements in the Municipal Hall. In view of the space requirements study, renovations in general have been kept to a minimum. However, office accommodation is urgently required for three additional staff members and we have no alternative but to provide the space now. Funds are provided in the 1988 Capital Budget under Municipal Hall, Code 60.


