1. THAT the Environmental Health Division participate in the Sapperton Fish and Game Club's 1989 Brunette River Open House.

R E P O R T

During the 1989 April 20 meeting of the Environment and Waste Management Committee, it was concluded that it would be beneficial for the Environmental Health Division to participate in the Sapperton Fish and Game Club's Brunette River Open House and adopted a motion to this effect.

Subject to Council's concurrence, Environmental Health Division staff have confirmed with the Sapperton Fish and Game Club Officials participation in the Club's Brunette River Open House. It is proposed that staff locate the Division's environmental emergency vehicle at a location alongside the Brunette River and demonstrate to the public various equipment and methods used for combating petrochemical spills into our waterways. Staff will also demonstrate the various techniques used for sampling and tracing pollutants.

Staff are currently working with the Sapperton Fish and Game Club on a location for the Municipal display.

The Municipal involvement in the Brunette River Open House is an excellent forum for educating the public on the environmental sensitivity of the Brunette River drainage basin and the services provided by our Municipality for protecting the environment.
