PURPOSE: To obtain Council approval for construction bylaws  
for the above lanes.

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RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT construction bylaws be brought forward for the construction  
and paving of the two lanes described in this report.

REPORT

On 1989 February 13 and March 06 respectively, Council received from the  
Municipal Clerk Certificates of Sufficiency covering the paving of the two  
lanes as described below, as a local improvement by the petition method.

Following is a cost report for each lane as required by Section 662 of the  
Municipal Act:

Imperial Street

Approximate length of work	278 m (911.80 feet)
Estimated cost of work	\$14,000.00
Actual foot frontage	911.80 feet
Taxable foot frontage	544.40 feet
Owners' share of the cost of the work	\$ 2,012.10
Estimated lifetime of the work in years	10
Frontage tax levy	5 instalments of \$1.00 per taxable foot

Cambridge Street

Approximate length of work	363 m (1,190 feet)
Estimated cost of work	\$18,000.00
Actual foot frontage	1,190.00 feet
Taxable foot frontage	1,190.00 feet
Owners' share of the cost of the work	\$ 4,398.24
Estimated lifetime of the work in years	10
Frontage tax levy	5 instalments of \$1.00 per taxable foot
