RE: COMMUNITY PLAQUE PROGRAMME

Recommendation:

1. That Council authorize an expenditure of \$525 for the purchase and installation of three engraved brass plaques for the identification of the following designated heritage buildings:

- a) Burnett House
- b) Seaforth School
- c) Smith House

as further outlined in the report.

R E P O R T

At the 1989 June 28 Heritage Advisory Committee Meeting, the Committee requested staff investigate the provision of two different distinct types of plaques; one for identifying designated heritage buildings and the other being an interpretative plaque to identify historic sites.

Information has now been obtained with regard to the costs of engraved brass plaques for identification of designated heritage buildings. These plaques are available at a cost of approximately \$175 each.

The Committee would now like to proceed to obtain three plaques to be placed on the three designated heritage buildings in Burnaby. It is hoped that the placement of these plaques will draw the community's attention to our historic buildings and contribute to an awareness of heritage in our community as well as provide permanent recognition of the significance of these buildings to our municipality.

The interpretative plaques for identification of historic sites, roots or commemorative events are still under investigation and will be the subject of a future report to Council.

The Committee therefore requests Council's approval of an expenditure of approximately \$525 (\$175 x 3) to purchase and install the engraved brass plaques.
