RE: PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAM

Recommendation:

1. THAT Council approve the placement of an article in one edition of Burnaby Now and Sunday News seeking public input regarding future plans for the Hastings Street area.

R E P O R T

The Hastings Street Advisory Committee, at its meeting held 1989 May 03 initiated a public awareness program which would see all residents and business people within community Plan Three (Hastings Street, Albert Street and Pender Street from Boundary Road to Willingdon Avenue) receiving a letter of introduction advising of the existence and purpose of the Hastings Street Advisory Committee. The letter would also invite those affected to submit their opinions, comments or any ideas they may have; for instance, should your block stay the same or, if not, what type of changes would you like to see; what type of business or other development would you support and how would you address parking?

To date, approximately 1,800 letters have been sent out.

Additionally, the Committee agreed to place articles seeking public input in the Burnaby Now, Sunday News, the Vancouver and Burnaby Heights Newsletters, Information Burnaby and the Svend Robinson Report.

The cost associated with the proposed article in Burnaby Now and Sunday News is not expected to exceed \$400.00 and, with Council's approval, will be charged to Council's Boards, Committees and Commissions account.
