SUBJECT: HEALTHY COMMUNITY PROJECT

PURPOSE: TO REQUEST APPROVAL BY COUNCIL TO SPEND UP TO \$5,000 ON
PROMOTIONAL INFORMATION AND PUBLIC FORUMS TO SUPPORT THE
HEALTHY COMMUNITY PROJECT

RECOMMENDATION:

- I. That the committee designated by Council, Alderman Sawicki, Alderman Begin, and School Trustee Carol Jones, be authorized to spend up to \$5,000.

BACKGROUND:

On March 13, 1989, Council approved in principal the expenditure of a \$15,000 Ministry of Health Grant, on a project to promote a "Healthy Community". A committee designated by Council, Alderman Sawicki, Alderman Begin, and School Trustee Carol Jones, was authorized to prepare the Terms of Reference and hire a consultant to carry out an overview assessment of Burnaby as a "Healthy Community" and to identify areas for possible further study and municipal action. The U.B.C. Centre for Human Settlements was hired as project consultant in July 1989.

Further to this, the Committee met with the consultants August 10th and determined there is a need for funds to cover advertising, public meetings, renting meeting rooms, etc.

It is the recommendation of this Committee that Council approve expenditures up to \$5,000 for the stated purpose and that the Committee be authorized to spend the funds.
