SUBJECT: PROPERTY ACQUISITION COSTS - SOUTH BURNABY WATERMAIN

PURPOSE: To obtain Council authority to appropriate \$56,000 from the 1989 Capital Budget for Burnaby's share of property acquisition costs related to the construction of South Burnaby Watermain - StageII.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council appropriate \$56,000 from the 1989 Capital Budget for Burnaby's Share of Property Acquisition costs related to the construction of South Burnaby Watermain Stage II.

REPORT

The Corporation in an agreement dated August 1970 agreed to share equally with the Greater Vancouver Regional District, the capital cost, including property acquisition, of the South Burnaby Watermain - Stage II. The 48 inch diameter main, was completed by the GVRD in 1986, and is intended to improve the water supply to Burnaby and other downstream Municipalities. It starts from Imperial Street at Waverley Avenue and connects with the Annacis Main in the vicinity of 15th Avenue and 19th Street. The alignment is generally along the skytrain right-of-way.

Total property acquisition costs for statutory right-of-way of BC Hydro Lands have now been finalized at \$112,000. The Corporation's share of this cost is \$56,000. Funds will be provided in the 1989 Recast Capital Budget, under Code 21, Watermains, Pumping Stations, Right-Of-Way Acquisition Costs, etc.
