RECOMMENDATION:

"THAT Council endorse and support the Vancouver City Police Department's theft from auto program which involves neighbouring municipalities, including Burnaby, and that an article be placed in Information Burnaby to this effect."

REPORT

At the Crime Prevention Committee meeting held on 1989 March 15, the Committee reviewed the Municipal Policing Quarterly Report (October, November, December 1988) Item No. 17, Municipal Manager's Report No. 14, which was referred by Council to the Crime Prevention Committee on 1989 February 06.

Arising from the discussion with respect to this matter, the Committee was advised that a major incident of crime within the G.V.R.D. is theft from autos. The Vancouver Police Department have completed an extensive report on the matter which has resulted in three weeks being set aside in March/June/October whereby the Vancouver Police Department will commit 40 members to promote public awareness, education and enforcement of theft from autos.

The Vancouver Police Department have contacted neighbouring municipalities who have agreed to pursue theft from autos on the same basis as the City of Vancouver.

Your Committee wholeheartedly supports this program and recommends that Council endorse and support the program and that the citizens of Burnaby be advised of the program by placing an article in Information Burnaby to this effect.
