REPORT

In response to correspondence which appeared on the 1989 October 16 regular Council Agenda from E. and M. Snider, 4991 Rumble Street regarding excessive noise from a neighbouring privately owned rental facility we would advise as follows.

The facility which is the subject of the correspondence to Council is a small community hall owned by the Burnaby Host Lions Activities Society. The address of the hall is 5024 Rumble Street.

Upon receipt of a copy of the Snider's letter, Environmental Health Division staff contacted the Society's President and Secretary who were advised of the legal requirements of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw.

Both members of the Society acknowledged that there have been several problems with renting the hall to inappropriate groups and that better control over who rents the facility in the future would have to be exercised.

Staff have forwarded certified letters to the Society's Officials serving to legally notify the Lions Activities Society of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw requirements and that if further complaints were received and found justified Court action would be taken.

The Snider's have been contacted and advised of the action taken on their complaint and given the 24 hour emergency number for the Environmental Health Division. Staff will respond to any further complaints, record noise levels and proceed with Court action should violations of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw be recorded.
