PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for the parades mentioned.

REPORT

A request to use Municipal streets for a Remembrance Day parade on 1989 November 11 and a church parade on 1989 November 5 has been received from Branch 148 of the Royal Canadian Legion. In the context of the Street and Traffic Bylaw, this type of request is considered as a "parade" and therefore requires Council's approval.

Remembrance Day parade: originates at 4356 Hastings Street. Route will be east on Hastings Street, north on Alpha Avenue to the Confederation Park cenotaph and return.

Church parade: originates at the Confederation House at Albert Street and Alpha Avenue. Route will follow Albert Street west-bound to Burnaby North Baptist Church at 3977 Albert Street and return.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the parade be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshal or organizer.

2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered enroute.
3. That the parade be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the Municipality of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
4. That the Ministry of Transportation and Highways approve the use of Hastings Street.
