SUBJECT: CONTRACT NO. 8918
GLENCARIN DRIVE CULVERT REPLACEMENT

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the construction of a concrete culvert at Glencarin Drive

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Bray Enterprises Ltd., to construct a concrete culvert at Glencarin Drive for a total sum of \$107,500.00.

REPORT

Maintenance inspection of the Glencarin Drive culvert revealed that it is in a state of disrepair. A restrictive load limit has been placed on the culvert based on the recommendation of a structural engineering consultant. It is therefore necessary that the repairs be completed as soon as possible. Staff have obtained approval from the Provincial Ministry of Environment and Parks to work on this project up to 1989 September 30. This date fixes the deadline for completion of the work.

Due to the urgent nature of this work we invited three reputable contractors to submit tenders instead of following the normal public tendering process which would not have allowed us to meet the deadline for completion of this work. The three prices received for this work are:



| 2. Beaverdale Construction Ltd. | \$162,675 |
| 3. Targa Contracting Ltd. | \$128,437 |

The Acting Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$100,000.

Bray Enterprises Ltd. has performed similar works in the past and have recently completed the work of Contract No. 8803, Cariboo Heights Subdivision Area 2. They have performed very well in the past and come highly recommended.

The funding for this project is provided in the 1989 Capital Budget under Storm Sewers.

The Acting Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.
