**1.0 BACKGROUND**

Appearing elsewhere in the agenda is a letter dated 1989 August 24 from Mayor Gordon Campbell, Chairman, Development Services Committee advising of a review process for the further review of the report of the Greater Vancouver Transportation Task Force.

At its regular meeting held on 1989 July 24, Council received a staff report on the Task Force findings and adopted the following recommendation:

"THAT a copy of this report and the Greater Vancouver Transportation Task Force report be forwarded to the Burnaby Transportation Committee for the development of a position paper on the details of the Task Force report for submittal to Council."

The position paper is intended to provide a basis for a Council response to the G.V.R.D. Board on the report of the Greater Vancouver Transportation Task Force. Subsequently, at its meeting on 1989 August 24 the Transportation Committee considered a proposed process for the Municipality to review the report. Arising from the discussion on this report the Committee adopted the following motion:

"THAT the Transportation Committee approve the process for consideration of the Transportation Task Force Report in this memorandum with the addition of providing for the opportunity of public participation."

This report is intended to advise Council of the process adopted by the Transportation Committee for the review of the Task Force Report and its relationship with the process and timing described in the correspondence from the G.V.R.D. Development Services Committee.

## 2.0 PROCESS

The process approved by the Transportation Committee involves the preparation of a position paper over three meetings scheduled in September and October as follows:

- (i) Mid-September meeting – presentation of a discussion paper prepared by staff. The discussion paper would outline the major implications of the Task Force report for the Municipality.
- (ii) September 28 Public Meeting – a round table discussion of the Task Force Report by individuals from various interest groups in the Municipality.
- (iii) October meeting – consideration of a draft position paper for submission to Council based on the discussion at the September meetings.

The position paper and recommendations prepared by the Transportation Committee are intended to be submitted for consideration at the 1989 October 16 regular meeting of Council.

The letter received from Mayor Campbell proposes that Municipal comments on the Task Force Report be available for consideration by the Development Services Committee as follows:

- (i) Special meeting(s) – held by the Development Services Committee in late October to receive comments on the report.
- (ii) Regular meeting of the Development Services Committee – held on 1989 November 8 to prepare recommendations to the G.V.R.D. Board at its meeting of 1989 November 29.

At the time the Transportation Committee adopted its Task Force review process, it was aware of the timetable being proposed by the Development Services Committee. As such, it is making an effort to ensure that the Transportation Committee review timetable is compatible with that being followed by the G.V.R.D. Development Services Committee.
