REPORT

A request to use Municipal streets for a running race on Sunday, 1989 December 03, has been received from Tony Amstutz of West Coast Striders. In the context of the Street and Traffic Bylaw, this type of request is considered as a "parade" and therefore requires Council's approval.

The race will originate on Sperling Avenue just south of the Sprott Street intersection and will travel south on Sperling to Glencarin Drive, east on Glencarin to the hiking trails and will circle Burnaby Lake on the hiking trails, finishing at the Burnaby Sports Complex. The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the event be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered enroute.
3. That the race be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the Municipality of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
