REPORT


BACKGROUND:

On May 11, 1989, the Honourable Rita Johnston, Minister of Municipal Affairs, wrote to Mayor Copeland and Council confirming assistance for Burnaby under a new Public Health Equalization Grant revenue sharing program for the 1989-1990 fiscal year (letter attached).

A letter has now been received from Mr. Ron Zapp, Executive Director, British Columbia Centre for Disease Control, requesting three copies of an Agreement be signed by the appropriate authority for Burnaby. This Agreement will be co-signed by the Minister of Health and following completion, funding arrangements will be finalized.

This Agreement defines the terms used, how the budget will be determined and accounted for, and how the funds will be dispersed. A copy of the Agreement is available at the Clerk's office.

I recommend Council authorize signing authority so that the funding arrangements can be finalized.
