PURPOSE: To obtain approval of work orders #60-70-266,
60-30-066, 60-60-030, and 60-21-089.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT work orders #60-70-266, 60-30-066, and 60-60-030 as more specifically referred to in this report, be approved.

REPORT

60-70-266 Cariboo Road/15th Avenue Pedestrian Overpass

Charge: 1990-1994 Capital Budget \$420,000
Code 70, Land Assembly & Development Bylaw

Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda is an item recommending award of Contract #9012, 15th Avenue Pedestrian Overpass. This work order covers the cost of Contract #9012 including contingencies and other ancillary works. Landscaping costs associated with the pedestrian bridge are not included in this contract, but will be subject of a further report to Council when total costs are more clearly defined through the tendering process. This project is included in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget, under Land Assembly and Development and sufficient appropriated funds are in place.

60-30-066 Barnet Beach Sewage Lift Station

Charge: 1990-1994 Capital Budget \$100,000
Code 30, Sanitary Extensions

Additional Information: This work order pertains to the supply and delivery of a sewage lift station including all necessary valves, appurtenances and electrical kiosks. The station will form an integral part of the new sanitary sewer system proposed for the Barnet Beach area. It is being pre-ordered at this time in anticipation of extended delivery times. Construction is scheduled to commence later this year. Funds are provided in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget under Sanitary Sewers, Code 30.

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60-60-030 Office Renovations in the Justice Building

Charge: 1990-1994 Capital Budget \$50,000
Code 60, Municipal Hall

Additional Information: Alterations are required in the Justice Building to create a new Court Liaison Office and provide improvements to the exercise room in the R.C.M.P. detachment. Funds are provided in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget under Municipal Hall, Code 60.

60-21-089 Replacement watermain on Canada Way, Westminster Avenue to Royal Oak Avenue and Willingdon Avenue, Venables Street to Albert Street.

Charge: 1990-1994 Capital Budget \$430,000
Code 21, Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.

Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on this Council agenda is an item recommending award of Contract #8921, Replacement Watermain on Canada Way, Westminster Avenue to Royal Oak Avenue and Willingdon Avenue, Venables Street to Albert Street. The project consists of a 450mm diameter main to replace an aging steel main installed prior to 1930 which is subject to frequent leaks and high maintenance costs. Total estimated cost of construction, including supply and delivery of pipe materials and relocation of non-Municipal utilities is \$430,000, funds for which are available in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget, Code 60-21, Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.
