PURPOSE: To bring down a Combined Storm and Sanitary Sewer Sinking Fund Reserve Expenditure Bylaw

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a bylaw be brought down to appropriate \$1,330,000 from the Combined Storm and Sanitary Sewer Sinking Fund Reserve for sanitary sewer projects identified in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget.


REPORT

The Capital Budget identified \$1,330,000 worth of sanitary/storm sewer system works to be undertaken in 1990. The projects are:

Westridge to Barnet Beach - sanitary sewer	\$ 750,000
Eastbrook/Still Creek - sanitary pump station/main	280,000
North Burnaby - rehabilitation of combined sewer	200,000
Sanitary pump stations - upgrade alarm system	<u>100,000</u>
	\$1,330,000

The source of funds for the projects is the Combined Storm and Sanitary Sewer Sinking Fund Reserve. To use the funds, an appropriation bylaw is required. Council's approval is being sought at this time to have the required funding in place prior to the works being undertaken. Before any works are commenced specific approval for each project will be obtained from Council.

It is recommended that a bylaw be brought down to appropriate \$1,330,000 from the Combined Storm and Sanitary Sewer Sinking Fund Reserve for sanitary sewer projects identified in the 1990-1994 Capital Budget
