
PURPOSE : To request Council's authority (a) to re-allocate \$50,000 within the 1990 Capital Budget for an architectural review of twinning the Burnaby Lake Arena and (b) to retain an architect to review the siting of a third ice surface at the Burnaby Lake Sports Complex.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. THAT approval be given to the reallocation of \$50,000 within the 1990 Capital Budget from C.G. Brown Pool future expansion to architectural review of twinning Burnaby Lake Arena.
2. THAT approval be given to retain an architect to review the siting of a third ice surface adjacent to the existing arena and swimming pool at the Burnaby Lake Sports Complex.

REPORT

The Commission at its 1990 May 03 Committee meeting, discussed various options concerning a third ice surface in Burnaby. The conclusion reached at that meeting indicated an architectural review should be undertaken as to the siting and feasibility of twinning the existing arena at Burnaby Lake. This review would also look at a central administrative area for the complex.

The Commission as part of its deliberations had input from "The Burnaby Arena Users Group" and discussions with the Burnaby Winter Club who have expressed interest in developing new facilities. The architect would be asked to consider the points of view of these two groups as part of the review including the potential for curling opportunities.

There is a need to have further discussions with the two groups to define their needs, particularly the Winter Club. If the Commission concurs staff will initiate meetings with both groups.

The 1990-1994 Capital Budget provides \$100,000 for C.G. Brown Pool future improvements; it is proposed to reallocate \$50,000 of these funds, with Commission approval, for an architectural review.

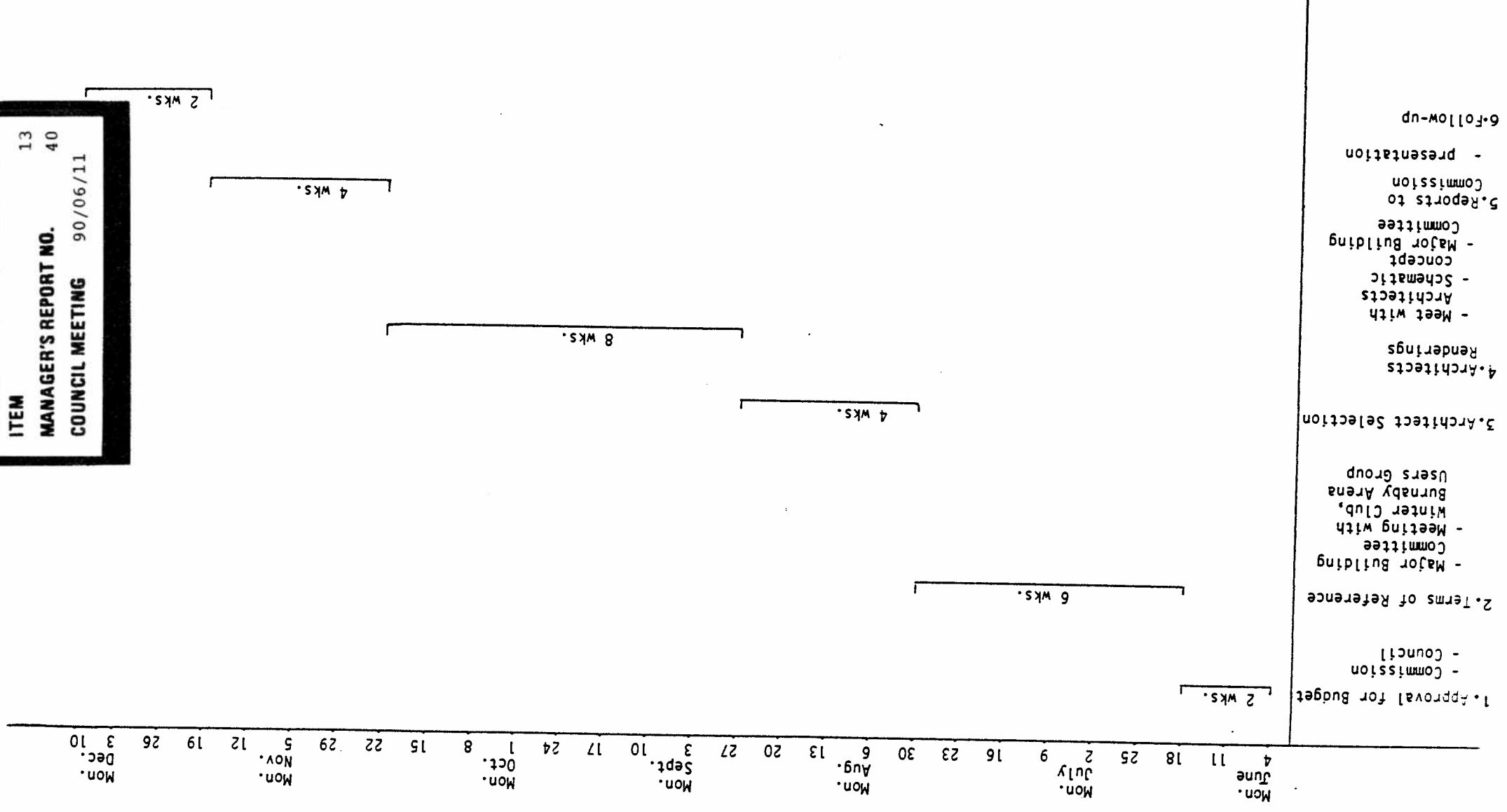
Attached is a timeline for the review which staff anticipate should be completed by year end.
