PURPOSE: To obtain approval of work orders #60-14-129, #60-14-139, and #60-32-088.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT work orders #60-14-129, #60-14-139 and #60-32-088, as more specifically referred to in this report, be approved.

REPORT

60-14-129 Wheelchair Ramps - Various Locations \$20,000
Charge: 1990 Capital Budget
Code 14, Traffic Management

Additional Information: The Municipality's policy on the installation of wheelchair ramps is to install them in all new curb and sidewalk construction or reconstruction. In addition, a special program is in place which enables us to respond to the needs of the handicapped by constructing ramps in existing curb and sidewalk locations. There has been a sharp increase in enquiries and requests for wheelchair ramps. This work order provides additional funding that will permit us to continue installation of ramps whenever feasible. Funds are available in the 1990 Capital Budget, Code 14, Traffic Management.

60-14-139 Design and Pre-Order of Signal Controllers for Traffic Control Devices at Various Locations \$40,000
Charge: 1990 Capital Budget
Code 14, Traffic Management

Additional Information: Engineering design services are required for the preparation of design drawings and contract documents related to installation of the following traffic control devices previously approved by Council:

- 14th Avenue and 6th Street
- McPherson Avenue and Imperial Street
- 16th Avenue and 6th Street (redesign of existing signal)

This work order covers the cost of design services and the pre-order of controller equipment.

Work Orders #60-14-129, #60-14-139, #60-32-088
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Installation is scheduled for early 1991 and request for additional funding for construction will be made when cost is more fully defined through the tendering process.


Funding for this work is included in the 1990 Capital Budget, Code 14, Traffic Management.

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60-32-088 Storm Improvements - Various Locations

Charge: 1990 Capital Budget \$170,000
Code 32, Storm Extensions

Additional Information: A program of storm improvements including ditch elimination and catch basin installations has been identified to ameliorate potential flooding at various locations. Funds are provided in the 1990 Capital Budget, Code 32, Storm Extensions.
