REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
RE: STILL CREEK AVENUE RECYCLING DEPOT - OPENING CEREMONY

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

The opening of the new recycling depot in the 4800 block of Still Creek Avenue (west of Douglas Road) is scheduled for Saturday, 10:30am, 1990 February 24. The following arrangements, shown in point form, have been or will be made for the opening of the depot.

1. Publicity

Advertisements will be placed in Burnaby Now, the Burnaby and New Westminster News and the Sunday News (a copy of the proposed newspaper ad. is Attachment #1).

Reporters from Burnaby Now and the News have undertaken to meet with staff so that an information article can be written in the issues prior to the opening. In addition, both local newspapers have been invited to have photographers present for the opening ceremony.

Apart from the newspaper publicity, all local radio stations have been approached and we have been promised some coverage. The local cablevision station has been contacted and we hope to have some T.V. exposure.

Notices will also be posted in Municipal satellite buildings open to the public.

2. Demonstrations

- a) Freon gas removal from refrigerators will be demonstrated by J.P.A. Appliances Ltd. and a technician will be present to answer questions.
- b) Mohawk Oil will have their large recycling truck on site and a 10 minute video on used oil recycling will be shown continuously in the trailer or outside if weather permits.
- c) Wendy Turner of G.V.R.D. is arranging for a backyard composting demonstration and will be on site with other personnel to answer questions.

3. Neighbourhood Information

Letters have been hand delivered to business addresses on Still Creek Avenue inviting participation of these local industries. A sample copy is Attachment #2.

Brochures

Several brochures on recycling will be available for distribution in the trailer office and the public will be able to walk through and ask questions.

School Board Participation

Staff have contacted Burnaby School Board to invite involvement of school children in the opening ceremonies. Although details have still to be finalized, we anticipate participation of school children.

6. Opening Ceremony Agenda

It is suggested that a short agenda be prepared for the opening ceremony. The official opening time will be 10:00 a.m. and it is recommended that Mayor Copeland and Alderman Sawicki, Chair, Environment and Waste Committee make a few opening remarks following which could be a ribbon cutting ceremony and tour of the site.

7. Refreshments

Light refreshments will be available and portable toilet facilities will be in place.

8. Canadian and B.C. Flags

These flags will be flown to add prominence to the site and occasion.

Re: Burnaby Recycling Depot


