PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the construction of traffic signals at various locations.

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RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Ricketts-Sewell Electric Ltd., to construct traffic signals at various locations for a total sum of \$190,360.00.

REPORT

Three tenders for this work were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday, 1990 March 01, and were opened by municipal staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. A tabulation of the tenders received is attached (Attachment A).

The work of the contract involves the supply and installation of all labour, materials, equipment (traffic signal controllers to be supplied by the Corporation), plant and tools related to the construction of traffic signals at:


- 18th Avenue - 19th Street
- Willington Avenue - Burke Street
- Sperling Avenue - Halifax Street
- 19th Street - Stride Avenue

The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$200,000.00.

The recommended bidder, Ricketts-Sewell Electric Ltd., is a reputable company which has been in business in the Lower Mainland for more than 40 years. They have constructed numerous traffic signals for various local municipalities, including those for the Corporation in 1988 under Contract No. 8809. Staff have found the contractor to be competent in the area of traffic signal construction and rate their past performance as excellent. The Director Engineering is confident that they have the necessary experience and resources to satisfactorily complete the work of this contract.

Funding for this work is provided in the 1989 Capital Budget under Traffic Management.

The Director Engineering and our consultant, R.P. Shaflik Engineering Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.
