An article inviting nomination of candidates for Burnaby's "1989 OUTSTANDING CITIZEN" appeared in the Burnaby Now, the Burnaby and New Westminister News and Information Burnaby. In addition, letters were sent to Burnaby service clubs, cultural, civic, athletic, veterans' and senior citizens' associations requesting nominations.


Eight submissions were received. They were reviewed by a Selection Committee appointed by Council. The Committee, after due consideration, selected Evelyn Salisbury as their recommended choice to receive the Kushiro Cup as the "1989 OUTSTANDING CITIZEN OF BURNABY".

Evelyn Salisbury, as a long time member of the Burnaby Historical Society, was instrumental in establishing the Burnaby Heritage Advisory Committee. Evelyn, by sheer tenacity, saved the Jessie Love farmhouse from demolition. This house was built in 1893 with the first building permit issued by the new Municipality of Burnaby.


In 1988, Evelyn was nominated by the Burnaby Arts Council for Women of Distinction Award (Y.W.C.A.).

Evelyn's other activities include Burnaby Historical Society, Provincial Red Cross, Audiometer Hearing tests (Burnaby) and spearheading the production in 1985 of "Windows to Burnaby's Past" - a two volume inventory of buildings of historical and architectural significance to Burnaby.


