REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held 1990 May 14 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

22/90 CARDIAC REHABILITATION PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

A letter requesting a grant was received from Cardiac Rehabilitation Program, New Westminster and District. This application is requesting funds to cover 1/2 - \$4,500 of the cost to purchase the Physio-Control Life Pak 9.

Upon consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that if there are any funds left at the end of the year, the Committee may consider the request, but as of now, recommend that it be denied.

23/90 VANCOUVER YOUTH SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$770 be awarded to the Vancouver Youth Symphony Orchestra.

REPORT

An application has been received from the Vancouver Youth Symphony Orchestra requesting a grant to subsidize tuition costs for students enrolled from the Burnaby area.

The Executive Committee recommends that a \$770 grant be approved for the Vancouver Youth Symphony Orchestra for 1990.

FOREST GROVE ELEMENTARY - 1ST PLACERECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$700 (\$100 per student - team of 7 students) be awarded to the Forest Grove Elementary School - "OM" Fund.

REPORT

The Forest Grove Elementary School has submitted an application requesting assistance with travel costs and room and board to travel to Ames, Iowa for the World Finals - 1990 May 31 - June 2.

"OM" (Olympics of the Mind) is a creative problem solving competition with an athletic games spirit...based on the belief that the mind, like the body, can be trained through practice and exercise to reach its fullest potential. The program stimulates students' creative problem solving abilities by providing challenging and interesting problems for the students to solve.

28/90 BIG BROTHERS OF GREATER VANCOUVER - BURNABY BRANCH

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$10,000 be awarded to Big Brothers of Greater Vancouver - Burnaby Branch for 1990 to cover the costs of rent, taxes and utilities on their Burnaby facility with the balance to cover operating expenses.

REPORT

An application has been received from Big Brothers of Greater Vancouver - Burnaby Branch requesting a renewal of their grant for fiscal year 1990/91.

Council, in 1987, 1988 and 1989 awarded a grant to Big Brothers of Greater Vancouver, Burnaby Branch in the amount of \$10,000 with the proviso that \$5,000 cover rent, taxes and utilities on the facility at 7443 Edmonds Street and the remaining \$5,000 cover operating expenses.

The Executive Committee recommends approval of a grant for the 1990/91 operating year in the amount of \$10,000 with the proviso that the rent, taxes and utilities for the municipal building be paid from these funds.
