

Re: Oakalla Redevelopment - Additional Public Information

Further to the letter dated September 7, 1990 from Mr. Dennis Truss, President and Chief Executive Officer of BCBC to Mayor Copeland and subsequent Council meeting of September 17, 1990, we would like to advise you that additional public information will be made available by BCBC by way of a full colour brochure, and a display which we would like to set up in the lobby of the District of Burnaby Municipal Hall. Dates and times for the display will be included in the public information brochure. It is also BCBC's intention to erect an additional information sign on the site. The sign will be erected as soon as possible, and the display set up for a period sometime between the mailing of the brochure and the public hearing.

After consultation with various subconsultants, we wish to advise that the schedule for completion and distribution of the brochure will be as follows:

1. Sept. 19 - Sept. 25, 1990 Preparation of written material and graphics for the brochure. This includes time for the District of Burnaby Planning Department to review the information to ensure that it is accurate and up to date.
2. Sept. 26 - Oct. 2, 1990 Preparation of material for printing.
3. Oct. 3 - Oct. 9, 1990 Printing of full colour brochures.
4. Oct. 10, 1990 Brochure available for distribution to the public.
5. Oct. 12 - 15, 1990 Distribution of brochure through Canada Post. A map of the postal areas to receive the brochure is enclosed.

We believe this is a realistic schedule which ensures that a high quality information package is prepared for the public and that even with minor delays the distribution date will be met.

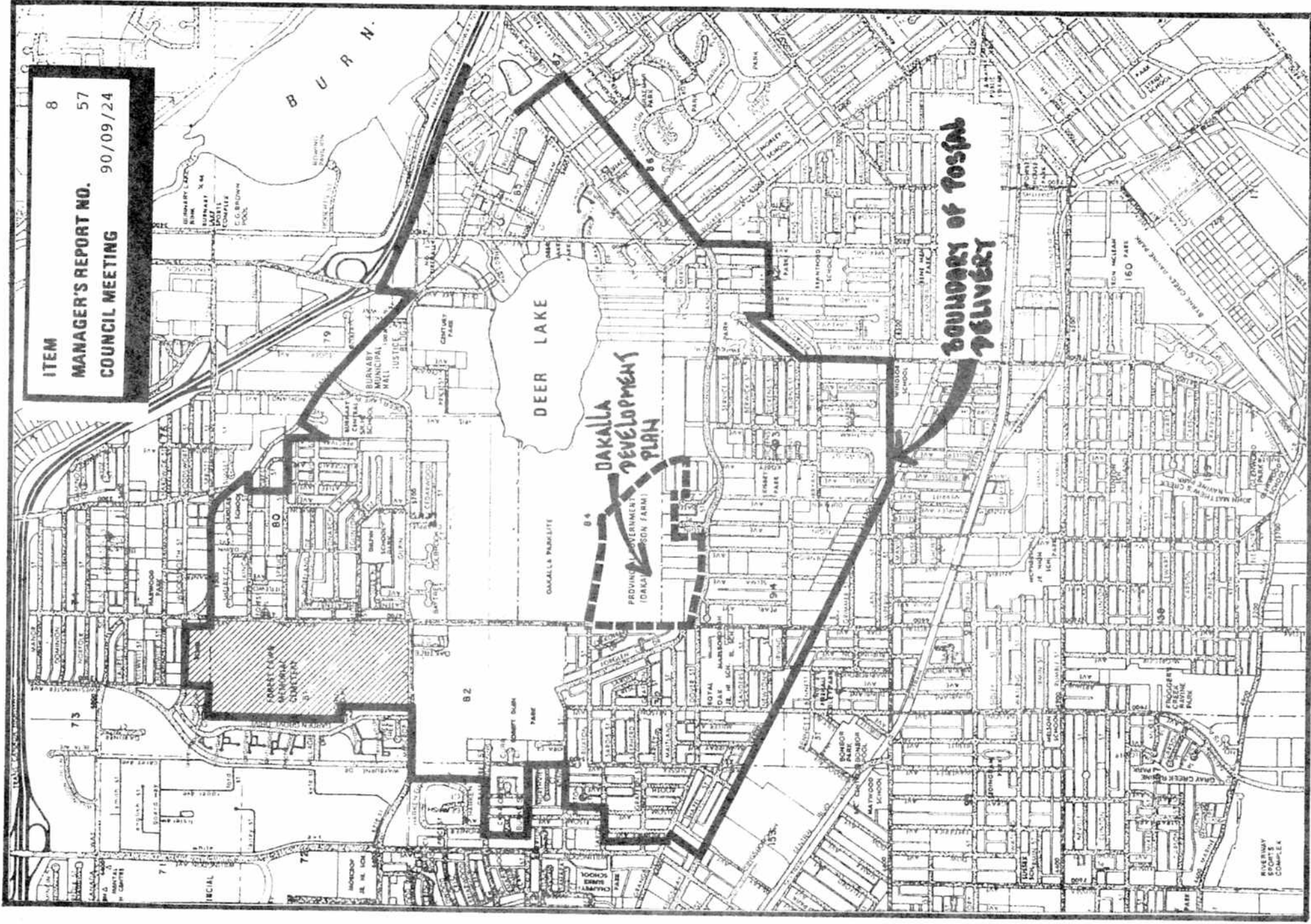
