RE: LETTER FROM G.V.R.D. WHICH APPEARED ON THE AGENDA FOR
THE JUNE 18 MEETING OF COUNCIL (Item 1) REGARDING
REGION-WIDE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) COLLECTION PROGRAM

MUNICIPAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council endorse and participate in the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program as further detailed in this report, and in the 1990 June 07 letter from the G.V.R.D.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1990 June 18, Council received a letter from the G.V.R.D. on the subject matter, a copy of which is attached.

The G.V.R.D. advises that this "interim" program is intended to fulfill the immediate needs for HHW management within the Region. Burnaby staff is also hopeful that the early implementation of a permanent system will obviate the need for a further "interim" HHW collection drive.

Burnaby's share of the cost of the collection drive is expected to be a maximum of \$20,000. The Municipal Manager will ensure that the required funding is in place and that staff participation and cooperation be afforded to the Program to the extent required for its success.
