REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Executive Committee was held on 1990 April 09 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

9/90

BURNABY VOLUNTEER CENTRE

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

An application was received from the Skillsbank Program requesting a grant in the amount of \$4,000. The program serves as a placement agency for people willing to volunteer.

After consideration of this application, the Executive Committee agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.

BURNABY UNEMPLOYMENT ACTION CENTRE

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$6,065.00, an increase of 5% over 1989 be awarded to the Burnaby Unemployment Action Centre for 1990.

REPORT

An application has been received from the Burnaby Unemployment Action Centre requesting a grant in the amount of \$15,840.00 to cover operating expenses for 1990. Council approved a grant in 1989 in the amount of \$5,775.00 for this organization.

Your Committee would recommend that the 1990 grant be increased by 5% over the 1989 grant which would result in a grant of \$6,065.00 for the Burnaby Unemployment Action Centre for 1990.

17/90 SIXTH CANADIAN STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT a decision with respect to the grant be deferred to the next Executive Committee of Council meeting.

REPORT

An application was received requesting financial assistance in support of Canada's National Leadership Conference to be held October 24 - 28, 1990.

18/90 WOMEN'S ICE HOCKEY TEAM

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

An application was received requesting financial assistance for the team's participation in the Western Shield in Edmonton.

Upon consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.

19/90 MAJOR ART GROUP

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT a grant of \$300 be awarded to the Major Art Group for 1990.

REPORT

An application was received requesting assistance to cover expenses. The Major Art Group is composed of approximately 22 senior citizens who enjoy painting. All members are senior citizens who are on a fixed income and the Major Art Group's only source of income is through annual membership fees. Council in 1989 approved a grant of \$300 to this organization and your Committee recommends that the same amount of \$300 be awarded for 1990.

20/90 GIFTED CHILDREN'S ASSOCIATION

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT \$600 be awarded to the Gifted Children's Association as a one-time only grant towards the purchase of a computer.

REPORT

The Gifted Children's Association of B.C., Burnaby Chapter submitted a letter requesting a grant to cover costs associated with the purchase of a computer.

The Gifted Children's Association is a non profit organization founded in 1983 with a broad aim of meeting needs of gifted and talented children. The Executive Committee recommended that a grant of \$600 be awarded on a one-time basis specifically for the purchase of a computer.

1/90 FORUM FOR YOUNG CANADIANS

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

An application was received requesting funding to help with tuition fees and travel expenses to and from Ottawa.

After consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.

2/90 SOCIETY FOR THE PRESERVATION AND ENCOURAGEMENT  
OF THE BARBER SHOP QUARTET SINGING IN AMERICA

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

A letter was received requesting assistance in the amount of \$5,000 to help with the travel expenses for New York trip (Carnegie Hall).

Upon consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.
