 SUBJECT: REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE - NOVEMBER 11, 1990
 PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for a Remembrance Day parade.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the Remembrance Day Parade as discussed in this report.
2. THAT the coordinator of the event, Pat O'Brien (President), 5289 Grimmer St., Burnaby, B.C. V5H 2H3 be sent a copy of this report.

REPORT

A request to use Municipal streets for a Remembrance Day Parade to be held on Sunday, Novemebr 11th, 1990 has been received from The Royal Canadian Legion Branch #83.

In the context of the Street and Traffic Bylaw, this type of request requires Council's approval.

The parade will form in the 6600 block on Dufferin Avenue at 9:40 A.M. and will disperse at approximately 10:10 A.M. and proceed west on Kingsway, south on Royal Oak Avenue, east on Grimmer Street to the legion premises.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the parade be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered enrout.
3. That the parade be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the Municipality of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
4. Ministry of Transportation and Highways approval must be obtained for the use of Kingsway Street.
