SUBJECT: PYROTECHNICS DISPLAY AT THE HART HOUSE, 6664 DEER LAKE AVENUE, BURNABY, B.C. - SATURDAY, JULY 14TH, 1990 - FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M.

PURPOSE: TO OBTAIN COUNCIL APPROVAL FOR A PYROTECHNICS DISPLAY.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the request to discharge fireworks at the Hart House on 1990 July 14 between the hours of 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. be approved, subject to full compliance with all the conditions as required by the Burnaby Fire Department.
2. THAT a copy of this report be forwarded to Mr. Paul Smolen, General Manager of the Hart House, 6664 Deer Lake Avenue, Burnaby, B.C. V5E 2L8.

R E P O R T

The use, set off or discharge of fireworks in Burnaby is permitted by Bylaw to take place in the period of October 25 through 31 each year. However, Section 933(1) of the Municipal Act permits Council to authorize the issuance of a permit to a person or organization for the purpose of the observance or celebration of a special event or festival by the use of fire crackers or other fireworks of any kind, and may specify terms and conditions.

Attached is a copy of a letter received from the Hart House on Deer Lake requesting permission to hold a pyrotechnics display on Saturday, July 14th, 1990 from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The purpose of this report is to authorize, with Council approval, the use of fireworks for this celebration with the following comments and conditions.

The Burnaby Fire Department has no objections to the subject display provided that:

1. The Explosive Act of Canada is adhered to.

2. The fireworks supervisor must have a valid fireworks supervisor card issued by Energy Mines & Resources Canada.
3. The fireworks supervisor provide proof of a minimum of Five (5) Million Dollars Liability Insurance, with the Corporation of Burnaby named as an additionally named insured for this event. The policy must include a Cross Liability Clause and a thirty (30) day written Notice of Cancellation Clause. In addition, a "copy" of this Liability Insurance is to be mailed to the Fire Prevention Division.
