RE: B.C. Community Action Program -
Grant Denial for Burnaby Coordinated
Area Multi-Service Team Youth Project

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council support the B.C. Community Action Program appeal of the Provincial Government's decision to deny a grant application for the Burnaby Youth Services Delivery System.
2. THAT Council authorize the Chairman and two members of the Community Issues & Social Planning Committee to meet with the Honourable Norman Jacobson, Minister of Labour & Consumer Services to discuss the Burnaby Youth Services Delivery System program.

R E P O R T

The Community Issues and Social Planning Committee at its meeting held on 1990 June 27, was advised that the application to the Provincial Government for C.A.P. funding for the Coordinated Areas Multi Service Team Youth Project had been denied. The Committee received a copy of a letter which Mr. Phil Makortoff, Co-Chairman of the Senior Advisory Committee to the project, sent to the Honourable Norman Jacobson appealing the Ministry's decision.

The Committee expressed concern with the Ministry's decision and as a result passed a unanimous motion to strongly support the Senior Advisory Committee's appeal of the Ministry's decision on the funding application. The Committee directed that Council be informed of the situation and be requested to send a letter of support on the appeal.

Both voluntary and statutory agencies assisted with development of the proposed youth services delivery model. Also, the ongoing involvement and support of youth servicing agencies and the broader community were seen to be essential to the model's success. The Municipality of Burnaby has demonstrated its commitment to, and belief in the model in several ways:

- Burnaby provided \$22,000 in consultant fees to assist with the model's development;
- Burnaby authorized staff from our Planning & Building Inspection, Parks & Recreation, Health, and RCMP/Youth Services Departments to play a leadership role in developing the model;
- Burnaby committed \$50,000 towards the pilot implementation of the model.
