REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held 1990 May 22 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

29/90 COUNCIL OF PARENT PARTICIPATION PRESCHOOLS IN B.C.

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

A letter requesting a grant in the amount of \$1,181.61 was received from the Council of Parent Participation Preschools in B.C. This application is requesting financial assistance to cover the cost of books and materials (\$781.61) to be shared among the schools and the purchase of a typewriter (\$400.00).

Upon consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that if there are any funds left at the end of the year, the Committee may consider the request, but as of now, recommend that it be denied.

30/90 THE VANCOUVER PLAYHOUSE

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$3,000 be awarded to the Vancouver Playhouse.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from the Vancouver Playhouse requesting a grant for support of their 1990/91 season.

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held on 1990 June 18 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

17/90 SIXTH CANADIAN STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Central Secondary School (6th Canadian Student Leadership Conference) and further;
2. THAT the Corporation of Burnaby provide a mini-van with driver for the students from October 24 to 28. This service will be provided 'in kind' at a cost of \$353.00.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from the Burnaby Central Secondary School requesting financial assistance in support of 6th Canadian Annual Student Leadership Conference to be held from October 24 to 28, 1990 in Burnaby, B.C. The Conference traditionally attracts over 400 student leaders and their advisors from every province in Canada and the Territories. The main program focus is divided into three areas: developing leadership skills and practices; programs to assist mentally, physically, emotionally, economically and socially challenged students and to generate ideas for developing a student co-curricula program.

The Executive Committee recommends approval for a grant in the amount of \$1,000 to assist with banquet costs and \$353 'in kind' to provide a mini-van and driver from October 24 - 28, 1990.

31/90 SIMON FRASER UNIVERSITY

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from Simon Fraser University requesting a grant for support of Dance Free. The dance is called Dance Free, and as the name implies, it is a dance offered to its patrons at no charge.

There are three important features of Dance Free:

- . no alcohol
- . welcomes all SFU students
- . organized solely by volunteers

After consideration of this application the Executive Committee agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.

32/90 BURNABY FAMILY LIFE INSTITUTE

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

An application was received requesting a grant in the amount of \$43,000 to help maintain existing services during 1990/91.

Council approved - 1990 - \$11,955  
1989 - \$11,386  
1988 - \$10,396  
1987 - \$ 3,100

The Executive Committee understands that the Burnaby Family Life Institute has received a grant in the amount of \$80,000 in core funding from the Province. The Executive Committee awarded \$11,955 in 1990 March and therefore recommend that this request be denied.

33/90 FAMILY SERVICES OF GREATER VANCOUVER -  
BURNABY REGION

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

An application requesting a grant in the amount of \$10,000 relating to the family counselling program in Burnaby.

The Executive Committee agreed that if there are any funds left at the end of the year, the Committee may consider the request, but as of now recommend that it be denied.

34/90 TASK FORCE ON SENIORS HOUSING

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT grant in the amount of \$150 be awarded to the Task Force on Seniors Housing.

R E P O R T

A letter was received from the Task Force on Seniors Housing requesting a grant in the amount of \$150 to cover printing costs for the publishing of a brochure for 'Better Housing for Older People'.

Your Committee would recommend that a grant in the amount of \$150 be awarded to the Task Force on Seniors Housing.

35/90 COMMUNITY-CENTRED COLLEGE FOR THE RETIRED

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,000 be awarded to the Community-Centred College for the Retired.

R E P O R T

Council has awarded annual grants of \$1,000 to the Community-Centred College for the Retired since 1984. The College has once again requested Council's assistance with their ongoing educational programs for senior citizens.

After due consideration, your Committee would recommend a grant of \$1,000 be awarded to this group to continue their operations in 1990.

36/90 GARDEN VILLAGE PRESCHOOL

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,750 be awarded to Garden Village Preschool.

R E P O R T

An application has been received requesting a grant to help offset relocation (sewer and water connection) costs to move from Windsor Secondary School to a portable classroom.

Your Committee has considered this request and would recommend that a grant in the amount of \$1,750 be awarded for the sewer and water connection to the portable classroom.

37/90 MOTHERS AGAINST DRINKING DRIVERS  
CANADIAN SOCIETY (MADD)

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$100 be awarded to the Mothers Against Drinking Drivers Canadian Society (MADD).

R E P O R T

An application was received for a grant to cover program and information material costs. It is the Committee's opinion that a grant in the amount of \$100 would be appropriate for 1990 but as a 'one time only' donation.

38/90 BURNABY MULTICULTURAL SOCIETY

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$2,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Multicultural Society for 1990.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from the Burnaby Multicultural Society requesting a grant to help defray a portion of their increased program costs in the amount of \$9,000. The Society contributes towards the life of the Municipality through its services to residents and promotional activities. The Burnaby Multicultural Society has received Council grants in the past as follows:
