PURPOSE: To request Council's approval for Junior/Senior fees for the
Burnaby Mountain Golf Course for 1991
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RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the golf fee schedule outlined in this report be approved.

REPORT

At its meetings of 1990 August 01 and October 03, the Parks and Recreation Commission dealt with golf fees for the Junior/Senior category of play at Burnaby Mountain Golf Course.

The Commission is recommending the following schedule of fees:

1. 18 hole daily - restricted to 5 weekdays except for holidays \$ 9.00
2. 10 round pass - restricted to 5 weekdays except for holidays \$ 78.50
3. Annual pass - restricted to 3 days each week Monday through Friday except for holidays \$350.00
4. Combination 50 round and 20 round pass \$380.00


50 round: 18 holes - restricted to 5 weekdays except for holidays; and

20 round: 18 holes - weekdays except holidays November 01 to February 28; or

- twilight weekdays except holidays January 01 to December 31; or
- temporary greens January 01 to December 31; or
- 9 holes January 01 - December 31 (back 9 holes); or
- 2 punches for 18 holes weekdays except holidays March 31 - October 31.

Pass will extend to following year if not used up.

The Commission would recommend Council approval of this schedule. If approved, it will be included in the 1991 Burnaby Recreation Facility and Equipment Fee Bylaw.
