RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council concur in the removal and replacement of trees in the 4100 block William Street as outlined in this report.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1991 January 14, Council heard in delegation Mr. Phil Mattia on the above subject. Council adopted the following resolution

1. "THAT Municipal Staff, in consultation with Mr. Phil Mattia, prepare a report regarding a program for removal of trees in the 4100 block Williams Street including the transplanting of trees currently in place, replacement of those trees and associated costs to be to be born by Mr. Mattia."

In response to Council's resolution staff have consulted with Mr. Phil Mattia, and as a result have received a deposit of funds which covers the removal of the existing trees (to be planted within Burnaby's park system), and the purchase and planting of replacement trees.

The project has been discussed with the remaining residents in the 4100 Block Williams Street, and has their support.

The existing trees could be scheduled for removal the week of February 18, 1991. The new planting will be in place by mid April 1991, unless advised otherwise by Council.
