SUBJECT: CARIBOO HEIGHTS, COLDICUTT RAVINE RISK
ASSESSMENT AND REMEDIATION PLAN

PURPOSE: To obtain Council's authority to expend funds for the
preparation of the Coldicutt Ravine Risk Assessment and
Remediation Plan.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$45,000 be brought forward for the preparation of the Cariboo Heights Coldicutt Ravine Risk Assessment and Remediation Plan.

R E P O R T

1.0 BACKGROUND

Council, at the Caucus Meeting "In-Camera" held on 1991 March 18, received the Municipal Manager's Report No. 20, Item #1 and adopted a resolution authorizing the Purchasing Agent to invite proposals to conduct risk assessment studies as well as preparation of a detailed in situ remediation plan for the refuse disposal area located to the west of the Cariboo Heights Area 7d.

2.0 EXISTING SITUATION

Proposals have been received and reviewed by staff resulting in a unanimous recommendation to engage Envirochem Special Projects Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$45,000.

In order to provide for the expenditure of these funds a Capital Reserves Fund Expenditure Bylaw needs to be brought forward.

3.0 SOURCE OF FUNDS

Funds for this work are included in the 1991-1995 Capital Budget under Land Assembly and Development. Furthermore, the expenditure is in conformance with the \$34.7 million capital spending program presented to the Executive Committee of Council.
