

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council be requested to bring forward a Bylaw under Section 682(2) of the Municipal Act, to enter into an agreement with the Burnaby School Board to contribute to the cost of playground equipment as detailed in this report.

REPORT

The Commission over the past months has received and approved four requests to provide financial assistance for the purchase of children's playground equipment. The four Schools which submitted requests and received Commission approval are: Nelson Elementary, Gilpin Elementary, Morley Elementary and Clinton Elementary Schools.

The Commission has approved \$12,000 in its 1991 Capital program for the four projects. Each project will receive \$3,000.

The Commission does not have the authority to give direct grants. Therefore, funds are provided through Council's authority under a Bylaw. Section 682(2) of the Municipal Act states that Council may by law, enter into an agreement with a Board of School Trustees for the purpose of:

- (a) jointly constructing, maintaining, operating or using, or
- (b) contributing to the cost of construction, maintenance, operation or use of facilities for community uses on a site the title of which is vested in or held by a party to the agreement or on a site leased from the Province by a party to the Agreement.
