
The Heritage Society of B.C. Annual Conference is to be held in Revelstoke from May 23 - 26.

Two members of the Heritage Advisory Committee, Mrs. Charlotte Murray and Dr. Edward Gibson, have expressed a willingness to attend on behalf of our Committee. The approximate cost including registration would be \$1,250 per person.

The Conference workshop topics include "Inventories in the Context of Heritage Management Planning" and a review of the newly released White Paper on Heritage Legislation. In view of the Committee's activities toward the development of a Heritage Management Plan for Burnaby, the Conference presents an excellent opportunity to examine these topics in detail with several experts in this field.

Therefore, I would respectfully request Council's positive response to our request to allow two Heritage Advisory Committee representatives to attend the 1991 Heritage Conference.
