

At its meeting of 1991 June 19, the Parks & Recreation Commission received the attached staff report on the above subject and adopted the two recommendations contained therein.

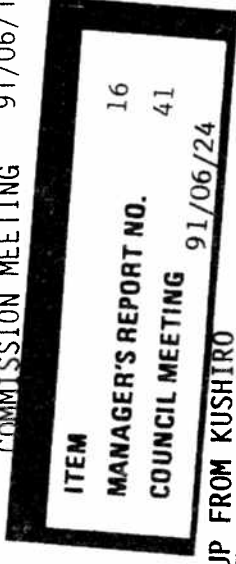

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT approval be given to provide complimentary passes for admission to the Burnaby Village Museum and Central Park Pitch & Putt for a group of guests from Kushiro.
2. THAT Council be so advised.

REPORT

Attached is a letter from Alpha Secondary School requesting assistance in the hosting of a group of students and adults from Kushiro in July.

The letter will have been placed on the Council Agenda for the first and fourth requests to be dealt with.

The second request is for complimentary passes for the Burnaby Village Museum. The group will consist of 30 students and 11 adults. The group rates are \$2.50/student and \$3.50/adult. Therefore, this represents \$113.50 in gate admissions.

The third request is for complimentary passes for a round of golf at Central Park Pitch & Putt for the same group. This request represents \$137.80 in admission fees, excluding G.S.T. The group has indicated they will rent any equipment which they require.

There is no precedence for a similar request from groups visiting from our sister city that staff are aware of. However, staff would recommend approval of this request to show continued support of the Kushiro sister city relationship.

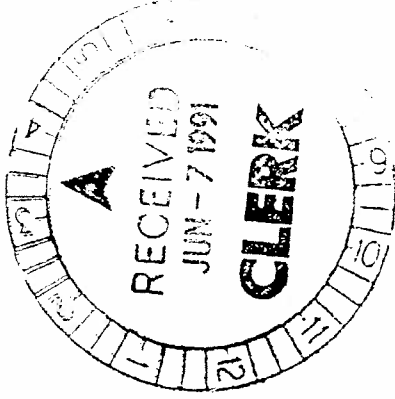

The staff and students of Alpha Secondary are hosting 15 students and 6 adults from Kushiro in July. This is the reciprocal portion of the exchange for which our students and staff participated last summer. As you are aware the significance of the 25th anniversary of our sister city relationship was quite important to our friends in Kushiro and I understand that your group that travelled last summer was as royally treated as were the staff and students of Alpha secondary. It is now our task to host the people from Kushiro in a way that reflects the tremendous hospitality that they have shown our Burnaby visitors in the past years. It is with this in mind that we request your support for the hosting of the group this summer.

The first request is for you or one of the council members to greet the Kushiro students when they arrive on July 27, 1991 at Schou Education Centre between approximately 2:00-3:00 o'clock.

The second request is for you to help us in bringing our guests and their hosts to Burnaby Village Museum on Tuesday, July 30, 1991 by arranging for complimentary passes for the group. (approx 40 persons)

The third request is for you to assist us in the hosting of the Kushiro guests and their hosts to play a round of golf at the Central Park Pitch and Putt course as guests of Burnaby.

The fourth request is for you and your wife to attend our farewell banquet on August 2, 1991 at Schou Education Centre. In addition, we also request the municipality's support in sponsoring the dinner for that evening. Total participation would be approximately 100 persons including the Kushiro visitors, host billets, host parents, and invited dignitaries.

As a person who has visited Kushiro I am sure you are aware of the importance and formality of these visits are to our Kushiro friends. We would like to return the generous hospitality that they have offered to us on our visits, with a program that reflects the support and generosity of the people of Burnaby towards the Kushiro sister city relationship.
