SUBJECT: REGULAR FULL-TIME COMPLEMENT OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

PURPOSE: TO SEEK COUNCIL APPROVAL TO STAFF TWO (2) APPROVED,  
"FROZEN", REGULAR FULL-TIME MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE  
POSITIONS WITH THE R.C.M.P.

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RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve two positions be added to the regular full-time R.C.M.P. complement.

REPORT

The 1991 Municipal Budget approved six new Municipal Employee positions for this detachment. Two additional positions while supported and approved in principle were left for consideration later in the year.

The justification for these positions has been previously submitted. Over the past eleven months the need for additional clerical support has escalated and the situation is such that these two resources are desperately required.

The decision to delay authorization of these positions was prudent given the uncertainty which existed at that time. However, since May the R.C.M.P. Policing Agreement has been resolved, favourably to the Municipality. Further, the monies to pay for these two positions are in the 1991 Recast Budget (and in the draft 1992 Provisional Budget), and auxiliaries and regular members as available are being used to cover the workload.

Council approval to have these two positions added to the regular full-time complement is requested.
