RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve a paid leave of absence for Liam McCaughy in order that he may participate in the 1991 United Way Loaned Representative Program.

R E P O R T

At the regular Council Meeting held on 1991 June 17 Council received correspondence from the Burnaby Civic Employees' Union Local 23 requesting that a municipal employee be permitted a paid leave of absence to participate in the 1991 United Way Loaned Representative Program. Council referred this request to the Executive Committee for review and the following report outlines the results of that review.

Participation in the Loaned Representative Program involves paid absence from work on 1991 August 17 for training followed by a twelve week absence from work commencing 1991 August 23 to November 29, inclusive, to assist with the annual United Way fund raising campaign.

Burnaby Civic Employees' Union Local 23 have put forward the name of Liam McCaughy, a member of the Engineering Department, Sanitation Division as the 1991 participant. The Director Engineering advises that the Department could accommodate Mr. McCaughy's absence without too much difficulty.

In view of the valuable service provided to our community by the United Way, the Executive Committee is recommending the municipality participate in the 1991 Loaned Representative Program by providing a paid leave of absence for Mr. Liam McCaughy for a period of twelve weeks.
