RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, E.B. Friesen Associates Ltd., for the upgrading of the Byrne Creek bridge at Royal Oak Avenue, for a total cost of \$189,818.00 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Two tenders for the upgrading of the Byrne Creek bridge at Royal Oak Avenue were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Monday, 1991 July 29 and were opened by municipal staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. A tabulation of the tenders received is attached (Attachment A).

The work of this contract involves the supply of all necessary labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the upgrading of the Byrne Creek bridge at Royal Oak Avenue and for the installation of the watermain needed for the Riverway Golf Course.

The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$187,250.

The recommended bidder, E. B. Friesen Associates Ltd., has been in business in the lower mainland for six years. Engineering staff have checked their references and have learned that, on projects of a similar nature, they are considered to be able, conscientious and cooperative.

The funding for this work is provided in the 1991-1995 Capital Budget under Storm Extensions and Parks Major Projects and is in conformance with the objectives established in the recent capital program expenditure review.

The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.
