

The following summarizes policing activities for Burnaby Detachment.

**TRAFFIC SECTION** were involved in the investigation of four fatal motor vehicle accidents, two of which involved pedestrians.

This section continues enforcement in school zones and commercial vehicles in addition to regular enforcement throughout the Municipality. Seat belt enforcement is a continuing program. The Section's "Hit and Run" Detail was increased by two members as a result of an increase in reported hit and run accidents. Preliminary results appear favourable.

**GENERAL INVESTIGATION SECTION** were involved in two murder and one attempted murder investigations. Charges were laid in both murders, while the investigation of the attempted murder is continuing.

Armed Robberies continue to increase. This quarter there were 47 Armed Robberies, 10 involving financial institutions, 1 jewellery store where approximately \$80,000.00 worth of jewellery was taken and 26 other miscellaneous type businesses.


Approximately \$100,000.00 worth of stolen property was recovered with 12 charges being laid.

Auto Thefts continue to be a problem, 14 stolen autos were recovered during this period.

**DRUG SECTION** are involved in Court preparation. They were also involved in 15 investigations, seizing cocaine, marihuana and marihuana plants as well as a quantity of "grow" equipment. 18 charges resulted from these investigations.

**IDENTIFICATION SECTION** were involved in 533 investigations, identifying 40 criminals from their examinations.

There were 12 hazardous pursuits during this quarter.
