

STAFF'S DECISION NOT TO REMOVE A BOULEVARD TREE ON BOUNDARY ROAD**
PURPOSE : To advise Council that staff's decision remains not to remove the
tree in question.

RECOMMENDATION:

REPORT

The flowering cherry trees on Boundary Road boulevard in front of Mr. Berry's house are 13 year old and in very good condition. They are approximately 15 feet tall and do not block the view from Mr. Barry's house. The annual pruning program will ensure the trees are maintained at that height. Burnaby's tree policy states that trees on public lands will not be removed because of views, shade or leaf drop. Therefore, staff does not recommend the removal of the tree.
