SUBJEC: BURNABY'S CENTENNIAL "TWILIGHT PARADE"
PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for the Burnaby Centennial "Twilight Parade" on Saturday, 1992 May 23.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the Burnaby Centennial "Twilight Parade" as discussed in this report.
2. THAT the following be sent a copy of this report:

REPORT

A request to use Municipal streets for a Centennial "Twilight Parade" on Saturday, 1992 May 23 has been received from Donald N. Brown, Chairman of the Burnaby Centennial Committee. In the context of the Street & Traffic Bylaw, a parade requires Council approval.

At this time, the Burnaby Centennial Committee has requested that the following Municipal streets be closed for a period of time during the evening of 1992 May 23:

- Nelson Avenue (Kingsway to Imperial Street)
- Jubilee Avenue (Nelson Avenue to Imperial Street)
- Bonsor Avenue (Central Boulevard to Bennett Street)
- Bennett Street (Central Boulevard to Nelson Avenue)
- Smith Avenue (Kingsway to Thurston Street)

The parade will assemble along Nelson Avenue and Jubilee Avenue and proceed westbound along Kingsway to Swangard Stadium. Some of the units will continue to march into the stadium for the Opening Ceremonies while others will disperse at Smith Avenue.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the parade be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.

2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.

The Corporation's liability insurance policies will be extended to include the activities of the Burnaby Centennial Committee and thereby provide insurance coverage for this parade.

As this parade requires the temporary closure of Kingsway, approval must be granted by the Ministry of Transportation & Highways. Measures will be required to re-route westbound Kingsway traffic and staff will participate in the pre-planning of the parade.
