60-08-023 Street an lane rehabilitation (1992 Program)
Charge: 1992 Capital Budget
Code 08 - Street and Lane Rehabilitation \$727,470

Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on Council's agenda is an item recommending award of Contract 9211 for works pertaining to the 1992 overlay program. The work consists essentially of grinding existing pavements, supply and placement of new asphaltic material to a finished level. It is performed on an annual basis and forms an essential component of our ongoing pavement management program. The new cap of asphaltic overlay extends the useful life of the road surface and protects the Municipality's significant investment in its roads infrastructure.

This work order provides partial funding in the amount of \$727,470 for expenditures under Contract 9211. The additional requirement of \$296,004 is available in an existing work order previously approved by Council. Provisions for these expenditures have been included in the 1992 - 1996 Capital Budget, under Code 08, Street and Lane Rehabilitation.
