SUBJECT: FIRE DEPARTMENT 2ND QUARTERLY REPORT 1992

PURPOSE: To provide Council with information relating to the Fire Department's activities for the 2nd Quarter of 1992.

RECOMMENDATION:

R E P O R T

\* This Department responded to 2,656 incidents during the 2nd quarter of 1992. Of these, 83 were fires which involved property estimated at a value of \$41,024,694 and a loss of \$972,831, and were the result of the following acts or omissions:

\* Forty-three firefighters suffered inhalation/exposure or were in vicinity of smoke/hazardous materials, and 17 sustained minor injuries (lacerations, contusions, sprains, strains, etc.) with no time loss. Five firefighters were off work due to lacerations and sprains.
